What is 4-H? 4-H is a community of young people across America who are learning leadership, citizenship and lifeskills. There are over 7 million 4-H'ers in the United States and over 245,000 Kentucky 4-H members making 4-H the largest out-of-school youth program. Everyone, ages nine to nineteen, can participate in the 4-H program. 4-H is a part of the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service. In 4-H youth learn lifeskills which will benefit them forever. The Kentucky 4-H program focuses on seven core content areas: Animal Science, Communications, Family and Consumer Sciences, Leadership, Health, Natural Resources and Science Engineering and Technology (SET).
