Directions to Lecture:

From Interstate 65:

Take exit #20 onto the Natcher Parkway. Take the first exit (#4) and turn left (south) onto Nashville Rd. The WKU Farm is on the left. Just past the farm, turn left at the stop light onto Elrod Road. The entrance to the Agricultural Exposition Center is the first drive on the left. **406 Elrod Rd.**

PLANTING DESIGN -
IT'S ABOUT MORE THAN PRETTY PLANTS

Gary Koller focuses on the design process of using plants in the garden. He will discuss creating planting beds; making spaces to live in; shaping the lawn and devising planting compositions that are spatially and visually attractive year-round.

Gary Koller has been involved with Public Horticulture for over 30 years. He served as Curator of the Living Collections for the Morris Arboretum of the University of Pennsylvania. He then went on to be Director of Horticulture at The Arnold Arboretum of Harvard University, for over 20 years. He has taught courses on Plants at the Department of Landscape Architecture, Graduate School of Design at Harvard University and has taught a variety of planting design courses for Radcliffe Seminars and The Landscape Institute of The Arnold Arboretum.
